Dear Mr. Wang:

Under the Provisions of Section 107.807, previously Section 173.300b, Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, and based upon an application dated September 16, 2002 and the United States Department of Transportation inspection conducted at the above facility in June 2004, Beijing Tianhai Industry Co., Ltd. is issued revised Approval Number 300b-88-03. This approval authorizes the manufacture of DOT Specification 3AA and 4L cylinders at Beijing Tianhai Industry Co., Ltd's facility at Huang Chang Road, Chao Yang District, Beijing China under the supervision of an independent inspection agency approved for that purpose in accordance with § 107.803.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1. The registration number **M-8803** must be marked on all DOT cylinders which Beijing Tianhai Industry Co., Ltd. manufactures under this approval.
2. Beijing Tianhai Industry Co., Ltd. may mark to DOT 3AA and DOT 4L only those cylinders it manufactures in accordance with this approval and the applicable specification requirements.
3. In addition to the cylinder test reports submitted to persons stated in §§ 178.35, 178.37 and 178.57 a copy of each such report must be submitted to the Approvals Program.
4. If DOT cylinder production has not been undertaken for more than six months, the Approvals Program must be notified prior to resumption of production.


This approval does not relieve Beijing Tianhai Industry Co., Ltd. or its employees of any obligations imposed by applicable regulations. Violations of this approval or any applicable regulations, or failure to assure adequate independent inspection and verification, may be grounds for approval termination or other enforcement action as provided for in the regulations. Only the issuing authority may authorize variances from the terms of this approval. In the event any of the non-technical information submitted in your application for approval changes, the Approvals Program must be notified, in writing, within 20 days. Advance notice and written approval by the Approvals Program is required for any substantial change in manufacturing processes or procedures.

A copy of a revised approval issued under Section 107.803 to Authorized Testing, Inc. and cylinder specification verification test results from Cylinder Services, Inc. are enclosed for your reference.
